## PREP VESSEL FOR LAUNCH

## COMMISSION ENGINE/GENERATOR

Engine Start Up - *\$75 (per engine + materials &/or fluids needed)*

\*NOTE: This service verifies proper operation and is required if you're not operating your vessel at the time of launch. This "In the Water Start Up" includes checking the engine & transmission fluids, also a visual inspection for water leaks, & checking exhaust outflow.

Generator Start Up - *\$65 (per genset + materials & fluids as needed)* \_\_\_\_\_ (qty) (200)

\*NOTE: Verify Proper Operation- Includes: "In the Water Start Up" of generator fluid levels, & a visual inspection for water leaks, hoses, belt tension, engine cooling pump at impeller & outflow.

## COMMISSION PLUMBING SYSTEM

Complete commissioning of entire water system (*Price is dependent on the needs of your boat*) Enter Each Code.

AUTOMATIC BATTERY REPLACEMENT

If a battery is dead at the time of launch & load test determines that it is bad, please replace with a comparable battery. \*We stock Lead Acid Interstate brand batteries. -Note: it is much easier to do this in the lift well. *(\$Labor)*

SHAFT & RUDDER LOG TIGHTENING/ALIGNMENT & BILGE PUMP

Inspect Shaft Packing (if at launch it is found that the packing leaking beyond specs, we will adjust packing hardware to specifications.) *(\$46.50 each)*

Inspect Rudder Packing (if at launch it is found that the packing leaking beyond specs; we will adjust packing hardware to specifications.) *(\$46.50 each)*

Check Dripless packing gland/burp the gland *(\$15.50 each)*

Check Bilge Pump Operation (make sure bilge pump turns on when the float engages for the auto feature) *(\$21 each)*

Align Drive Shaft – done after boat has rested in slip for 48 hours *(\$Labor)*

Lubricate &/or service folding propellers *(\$Labor)*

CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTOR & FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

Check exp. date on CO detector & install CO detector if needed *(\$Labor)*

Check exp. date, gauge, and condition on fire extinguisher(s) and install new if needed *(\$Labor)*

INSTALL SAILS & CANVAS /STEPPING MAST

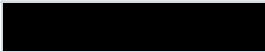
Bend on Sails – Make ready to sail *(\$Labor)*

COMMISSIONING BOAT TO/AT SLIP

Commission Boat to Slip: Operate boat to slip, tie off boat in slip, plug into shore power, check power to boat and check bilge pump. *(\$103)*

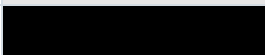
